Grade 9 and 10 students will be working on their Year End Reflection assignment on Wednesday. Students will be asked to identify and reflect on a significant learning experience they have had this year. Possibilities include (but are not limited to) achieving a personal milestone, learning through struggle or dilemma, having a breakthrough or an 'aha' moment. We emphasize with students that these learning experiences often happen beyond the school walls, and we encourage them to consider all possibilities. Once this Reflection Assignment is complete, each student will have the opportunity to sit down with an educator to discuss their experience. This assignment is a part of the Career Life Education curriculum. It is also mandated by the Ministry of Education that all Grade 9 and 10 students assess key learning experiences from the year and identify the Core Competencies that students are developing.
