We are happy to have you back in the building and want to make sure that we keep our school safe for everyone. It is important that all safety routines and protocols are followed closely.

WHAT YOU CAN EXPECT....

You will be greeted at the front door and asked to apply hand sanitizer before entering. Our new protocols will be explained to you:

- Maintain physical distancing at all times. Follow the arrows and pay attention to the signs at doors and in halls. Walk only on the right side of the hallway.
- Thoroughly washing your hands with soap and water is the best protection against illness make sure you wash your hands frequently and for at least 20 seconds
- If you have a backpack you have to keep it at the side of the room they cannot come to desks, and you cannot use lockers to store your materials
- Bring your own water bottle from home; water fountains are not available
- Pack food that does not require preparation (use of microwaves etc)
- Please take any garbage you have home with you
- Use only the seating that is assigned to you
- Stairways have signage to assist safe traffic flow. Some stairwells have been changed to one-way
- We may use the PA to have a controlled dismissal by floor
 - ·Bring your own technology where possible



Use of Bathrooms

Bathrooms assigned by floor/ area and students must use assigned bathroom

One person in the bathroom at a time—protocol is outside the door

Handwashing guidelines are posted inside the washroom
