*Grade 9 + Grade 11 Student Equity Scan Survey - Block A Classes Feb. 22-26

Beginning in 2016 the BC Ministry of Education created an *Equity Scan Framework* and vision to support school districts in understanding the things that help students be successful in school and also those things that may not be helpful for student success. Many students in our school district have a positive experience at school and are successful in their learning. Some students in our district have a less positive experience in school. Your feedback is important, and we want to hear from all of you.

IMPORTANT - Health & Safety:

As you have heard, the Ministry of Education has issued enhanced COVID-19 protocols in our k-12 schools. We are currently reviewing the revised document and will have new messaging out to our whole school community soon. A few key changes that will be in place are:

• All staff and students must wear a mask when in the building, even in learning cohort groups

- High intensity activity in PHE classes must take place outside, masks in PHE
- Music classes must adhere to distancing, even in cohorts

What we know is that distancing and hand washing are some of the most effective preventative measures to slowing the spread of COVID, along with mask wearing. We need students to distance when in halls, in hybrid classes and when on break and lunch. We will be reminding and supporting our students with these measures.

We ask that families continue to perform the daily health check and assure that your child has a mask.

Additionally, students in PHE should bring an extra mask to wear during activity.

Esquimalt High School's Mascot Design Contest!

Esquimalt High School is a diverse community with many different clubs, teams and initiatives. Although we have a strong school spirit, we currently have NO school mascot that represents our spirit and character. We are known as "the Dockers", but currently don't have a fun, spirit- lifting character to attend sporting, community, or other school events. During this time of COVID, the Esquimalt Leadership students believe that a school mascot would help bring our community even closer together.

Based on the results from our recent survey (88% in favour), we are continuing with the process of selecting a new school mascot!

Our goal is to select a mascot that represents the diverse, unique and inclusive culture of Esquimalt High School.

Required Elements:

- Designs should attempt to reflect both Esquimalt High School's **traditions**, as well asour **current context**.
- Designs should represent the **diversity** of Esquimalt High School's community and cultures.
- Designs must be something that can be manufactured into a Mascot costume.

All designs must be accompanied by a **brief** (150-word) paragraph explaining how the design incorporates the required elements.

Submissions must be received by Friday February 26th.

The Selection Process:

Step 1: Submit a **design** and **brief explanation** of how the design meets the required elements (~150 words) by **Friday, February 26th**.

Step 2: A committee of staff, students, alumni and community members will determine the **top three finalists** prior to Spring Break.

Step 3: Following Spring Break, an online vote will take place to determine the TOP design!
