2. Minutes of August 22, 2022 Meeting- George

3. Treasurer's Report -Ryan

- Ledger Balance-As of October 1st the Foundation's bank balance stood at \$5,913.94 with one outstanding cheque for the Rainbow Kitchen's RibFest profit share in the amount of \$2,225.00 leaving a Ledger Balance of \$3,688.94. Appendix "A" Draft General Ledger November 1, 2021 to October 31, 2022
- RibFest Revenue and Expense-Ryan reported that Ribfest was a financial success this year with total revenue to the Foundation of \$9,881.07 and total expenses paid out by the Foundation of \$3,243.58 leaving an excess of revenues over expenditures for RibFest of \$6,637.49. - Draft Financial Statements for AGM- Ryan provided draft financial statements for presentation at the AGM which included the Statement of Financial Position, Statement of Operations and Proposed Budget for the Foundation's 2022-2023 fiscal year. These drafts have not yet been reviewed by the Financial Reviewer which must take place before the AGM. The Statement of Operations shows that overall, the Foundation is expected to have an excess of revenues over expenditures of \$1,209.36. 4. RibFest 2022-Summary- Dave

Dave reported that this year's RibFest was the most successful in 10 consecutive years of RibFest (2020 was not directly comparable since it was a different event, a drive through event because of Covid-19 distancing measures). The Saturday crowd was huge and we did well at the Langos booth with brisk sales of Langos, bottled water and pop. By 6:30 PM on Sunday everything had been sold-about 1100 Langos, 1500 water bottles and 1500 pops- and so there were no returns to the suppliers. The three participating organizations, the Rainbow Kitchen, EHS Leadership Class and Alumni Association, received about \$2,200 each as their share of the profits from the Langos booth. Comments from customers were very positive about the Langos booth. Those customers were generous as well contributing almost \$600 in tips over the three days of operation. Overall RibFest also did very well. In addition to its other revenues the organization received about \$70,000 in donations at the gate. All of the money received by Ribfest net after expenses are paid goes back into the community to benefit the people in Esquimalt. For instance, this year Ribfest will put another \$60,000 into the turf field fund and \$10,000 into the Jason Buie Scholarship fund from its income. Going forward the three organizations participating in the operation of the Langos booth will have to revisit their pricing structure which is very modest, \$1.00 for a bottle of water, \$1.50 for pop and \$4.20 for Langos (average price).

5. Fundraising 2022-2023-Donation Requests-All

Detailed discussion of fundraising was put off until the next meeting in January. Both the turf field and scholarship funds will be mentioned in the Newsletter coming out at the end of October and donations invited for those funds. There have been a number of repeat donors and donations annually over the years have amounted to a sizable amount.

6. AGM Preparation-All

The Foundation AGM will have the same format as the Association AGM. It will be a hybrid in person and Zoom meeting with George acting as moderator for both AGM's. Brenda O'Connor will supervise the Association's election of officers and Marilyn McCrimmon will do the same for the Foundation.
