## **Challenge Information Night: January 15<sup>th</sup>, 2025 at 7:00pm at Mount Douglas High School**

Parents and students are invited to attend an information evening regarding the 4C Challenge programs offered by Esquimalt and Mount Doug respectively. The evening will provide parents and students an opportunity to further understand the 4 C Challenge program. The evening will include: a presentation from both school's challenge coordinators; student testimony; opportunity to engage with Challenge teachers and students; and a question and answer session with the challenge coordinators.

## **District Testing: January 29<sup>th</sup>, 2025**

Testing will occur at Esquimalt High in our library. The District Challenge Testing process makes use of the OLSTAT Lennon, and CCAT tests and includes a small written component. Testing usually takes 2 hours.

## **Portfolios Due: January 29<sup>th</sup>, 2025**

Portfolios may be submitted in hard copy (in a binder), or digitally via email or USB drive. Applicants may also submit their portfolios at the District Testing Session. Portfolios should include a letter of intent from the applicant, that outlines the reasons they have for applying to the program, a copy of their most recent report card, examples of schoolwork they may be proud of (1 or 2 items), and any artifact that connects to/demonstrates their passion(s).
